

Rules and Regulations for Trade Exhibits/Stands at Middleton Show .

The entire risk and responsibility as regards all exhibits and in reference to all Consequential or other loss or losses arising therefore must wholly be borne by the exhibitor

.The Exhibitor shall indemnify the Show Society and the Irish Shows Association, in respect of any claim for any damage caused And any injury suffered , and exhibitor shall effect his/her own Fire and Public Liability Insurance in respect of the stand provided by the Show Society,and shall furnish Evedence of such Insurance.

Responsibility; neither the society nor any of its officers are servants shall be in any way responsible or accountable For anything that may happen [from any circumstances whatsoever] to exhibitors of their servants or visitors to the show Or any exhibit or property brought into the show grounds or anything else in connection With or arising out of, or attributed to the society And it is requested that None will become assigned to the show society when they are been forward to the show .

All exhibitors/trade stands are expected to list clearly on the application form the products/goods they intend to exhibit .This is to enable the society to allocate the various trades stands in what they consider the most suitably position. The society Also reserves the right to accept or refuse any exhibit.

The Sale of Water Pistols,Cap Guns, Pellet Guns, balloons, is prohibited on the grounds.
