GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Intending exhibitors are requested to peruse the rules and regulations and be prepared to comply with these.

The Society reserves the right to alter or cancel any class or competition at any time. The Society takes no responsibility for any accident or loss.

The Society has the option of canceling or amalgamating any class where less than three entries have been received

No prize awarded unless 2 compete; no 2nd prize awarded unless 3 compete and no 3rd prize unless 5 compete. This rule will be waived should the Judge consider there is special merit and record same in their book at the time of judging.

Any objection to any winner in any class or competition must be lodged with €50 to the Secretary in writing within one hour of the event.

Exhibitors are to understand that although every reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure the safety and welfare of the animals, the Society will not be responsible for loss or accidents, of any kind that may occur, neither will the Society be accountable for any accident that may occur to any person attending the show, whether as a visitor, exhibitor or otherwise.

The Society shall not in any way be liable for any claim for compensation or otherwise arising out of the holding, abandonment or postponement of the show, nor for any claim arising out of or connected with the show.

The decision of the judges will be final.

Anyone found interfering with any exhibit or disarranging any display will be asked to leave the Show Grounds.

For the convenience of exhibitors, the Society has arranged that a veterinary surgeon will be on call at short notice to attend to sick or injured animals but fees for his/her services will be payable by the owners concerned.

The winner of each trophy will be presented with a Munster Agricultural Society Medal and the Cup or Trophy will be retained and inscribed by the Society with the details of the winners.

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ANIMAL OWNERS INVOLVED IN SHOWING ANIMALS

The Irish Shows Association would advise all Animal owners who have their animals insured to have the Insurance Cover extended to cover them while showing Animals at Shows, we understand that it costs very little or nothing at all depending on who you have Insurance Cover with.

If you are one of the few who don't have cover we would advise that you think about putting it in place for this purpose. It may well be worthwhile.

The reason for us giving you this advice is to protect yourself in the event of your animal lashing out and injuring someone or damaging someone's property. If that were to happen and it is established that your animal was out of your control you may be held responsible, or partly responsible for any injury or damage caused and may end up paying all, or part, of any settlement reached.

The Irish Shows Association are proud to present the following Championships and wishes to acknowledge the generous sponsorships, which make these competitions possible. For the Efficient running of the championships all concerned are requested to read and observe the Rules set out below.

GENERAL RULES FOR Irish Shows Association CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019

ELIGIBILITY OF SHOWS

Shows wishing to participate in the 2019 Championships and be eligible to hold qualifiers must have collected the Championship Fund Levy (currently 5%) from Horse, Pony, Cattle and Sheep class prize money for the year 2018 and forwarded the amount so collected, in full, to the Irish Shows Association Head Office within the stipulated period of not more than 30 days from the date of their show. Alternative methods of meeting this obligation are not acceptable.

Any show or competitor in breach of the Rules set out below will be disqualified from participating or competing in these championships.

These General Rules and those relating to individual championships (where applicable) should be published in the show schedule and catalogue of the participating shows and must be strictly observed.

QUALIFYING ROUNDS (QUALIFIERS)

Qualifying rounds will take place at eligible shows selected by the Irish Shows Association.

RESPONSIBILITY OF SHOWS HOLDING QUALIFYING ROUNDS

Selected shows should hold a separate class for each qualifier from which the highest placed animals will qualify.

The qualifier class should be held as the first (1st) class in the relevant section of the show. Shows must ensure that the qualifiers are held strictly in accordance with the relevant rules.

No other sponsor may be involved in qualifying classes.

Shows may charge an entrance fee for each qualifying class. The I.S.A. will award a rosette to the successful animal(s) At the Final. No show may hold a qualifying class for any championship on the day of the final.

Animals qualified for finals are not eligible to enter in any other show class where the Final is held.

Shows must appoint competent well-briefed persons to act as Stewards, who must ensure that only animals (or other exhibits) which are eligible to compete and those whose documentation is in order are allowed to proceed to the judging ring.

Animal Passports must be read by a Veterinary Surgeon appointed by the show.

On completion of judging, Stewards must instruct the successful competitors to attend at the Show Secretary's Office within one hour

and to complete the necessary documentation for entry to the championship final.

The show must appoint a well-briefed officer, who will be in attendance at the Secretary's Office, and who will assist exhibitors to complete the necessary documentation for participation in the final and to collect the relevant entrance fee.

Show Secretaries must forward complete result cards, together with appropriate fees to the Irish Shows Association within three (3) days following the holding of the show.

N.B. Shows must return results card marked "No Qualifier" for any or all of the events for which no animal (or exhibit) has been selected.

RESPONSIBILITY OF EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors accept that the Judges' decision is final in all cases. Any abuse of Judges will not be tolerated. Where a dispute or case for complaint arises, the matter should only be dealt with under f. below.

Winners of qualifiers are themselves responsible for entering their animals (or exhibits) for the final in accordance with j. and k. above, within one hour of qualifying.

Winners of qualifiers will compete in the final.

The Irish Shows Association in conjunction with the sponsor reserve the right to alter or amend the rules of any competition as may be necessary or appropriate.

Shows and competitors must contact the National Irish Shows Office for details of any championships and not the sponsor involved.

Objections must be lodged in writing with the I.S.A. representative at the show or the Show Secretary within half an hour following the completion of judging, together with a fee of 50 euro, or other stated fee, which is refundable in the event of the objection being upheld.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF SHOWS HOSTING CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS

A deduction of 5% of the prize money is to be collected by the Show and forwarded to the Irish Shows Association within 30 Days of the final

Championship finals must start not later than 3pm on the day of the show and the advertised time of starting must be adhered to as far as practicable. If necessary, other show classes should be either postponed or relocated to allow for this.

NOTICES OF INTEREST TO CHAMPIONSHIP PARTICIPANTS IRISH LAW (EU DIRECTIVE)

Under Irish Law all horses moving from one location to another must be accompanied by their passports. It is in your own interest to ensure this is the case. Failure to do so is an offence under Irish Law and is liable on summary conviction to result in a fine up to €3000. All passports must be registered with the name of the current owner.

The owner of Champions and Reserve Champions are invited to submit the animals' passports to the I.S.A. Head Office where the placing will be endorsed and officially stamped with the seal of the Irish Shows Association as a permanent record.

Department of Agriculture, Food & the Marine SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS HORSES AND OTHER EQUINES

Premises Registration

As from May 1st, 2012, any premises (which included shows, fairs and markets) where horses or other equines are gathered must be registered with the Department. Owners/persons in charge of such gatherings are required to submit a completed application form for registration and to keep records of movements on/off their premises. Records must be retained for at least 3 years as they may be required by the Department for the purposes of tracing disease.

Records required are:

The name and address of the owner/person in charge of the premises from which the equine came
Premises registration number from which the equine came
Passport number/UEL number of the animal.

It is important therefore that the Show organizers should contact their local District Veterinary office in advance so that consideration can be given to compliance with the requirements above. Any further information on the requirements for moving horses and equines to shows will be provided on the Department's website.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Horse riding is a dangerous sport and all competitors in ridden classes are strongly advised, for their own safety, to wear appropriate head gear which complies with up to date safety standards.

DISCIPLINE

The Irish Shows Association expects and will insist upon appropriate behaviour from all Exhibitors and others participating in any of the activities at our Member Shows and will not tolerate inappropriate behaviour.

Inappropriate behaviour shall include but not be limited to the following:

Profanity, coarse or vulgar language or gestures towards judges or other Show officials.

Harassment or bullying, including using words or actions that threaten, intimidate or undermine judges or other officials before, during or following Member Show activities. Failure to follow rules and/or obey instructions. Abusing any animal.

Disciplinary Procedures:

Complaints of misconduct against an Exhibitor or other participant at a Member Show shall be investigated and adjudicated upon by a subcommittee appointed by the Irish Shows Association. The said subcommittee shall consist of three members of the board of the Irish Shows Association and shall be known as the Disciplinary Committee. The Disciplinary Committee shall seek to ensure the existence of consistent, effective, fair and transparent complaint procedures and shall act in accordance with natural and constitutional justice.

Procedure:

A complaint of misconduct/inappropriate behaviour against an Exhibitor or other participant in a Member Show shall be made in writing and delivered to the Secretary of the relevant Member Show within 72 hours. A copy of the complaint shall be sent by the Secretary of the Member Show to the National Secretary of the ISA. A copy of the complaint will be sent by the National Secretary to the person or persons against whom the complaint is made. A person or persons against whom a written complaint is made shall have a period of 14 working days from the date of receipt of the claim to reply to the said complaint; such reply shall be made in writing.

Both parties shall state whether an oral hearing of the complaint is sought. The Disciplinary Committee shall be entitled to hold an oral hearing in regard to the complaint whether or not sought. The Disciplinary Committee shall decide in each case whether to hold such an oral hearing in respect of the complaint, or any part thereof and there shall be no appeal from such decision of the Disciplinary Committee. The Disciplinary Committee shall, at any time, seek further information from either party. In the event of either party refusing or failing to provide such further information within the time specified by the Disciplinary Committee, the Committee shall be entitled to make a decision on the complaint and/or to hold an oral hearing of the complaint in the absence of a copy of such further information being received by the Disciplinary Committee from either party. The Disciplinary Committee shall be entitled to reject a complaint where, in the opinion of the Committee, it finds there is no basis for it.

Sanctions

In the event of a first incident of inappropriate/unacceptable behaviour being deemed to be proved against the offender, the Disciplinary Committee shall issue a written warning to the offender. In the event of any subsequent incident, the Disciplinary Committee shall be entitled to impose sanctions on the offender, including a prohibition on such offender participating in any of the events/activities at any Member Show of the ISA, provided always that in the event of a first incident of inappropriate/unacceptable behaviour being deemed by the Disciplinary Committee to constitute gross misbehaviour, the Disciplinary Committee shall be entitled to impose such sanctions on the offender as it deems appropriate, including the prohibition on such offender from participating in any of the events/activities of any Member Show of the ISA.

The decision of the Disciplinary Committee shall be final.

RULES AND CONDITIONS Prize Fund: €1,000 - Enter Class 29

1. This championship is confined to Registered Connemara. Three year Old Fillies
2. The progeny of Registered Connemara Sire & Registered Connemara Dam.
3. Exhibitors In both the Qualifier and the Final must have the CPBS Passport ready for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. **Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.**
4. More than one Filly may be selected at any qualifying Show to compete in the Final providing the judges & the ISA agree the standard of warrant such selection.
5. One of the Judges at the final must be from CPBS judges list.
6. Ponies qualified for Final are not to enter any other class at Ballinasloe Show
7. Plaiting of Manes & Tails are not allowed for Qualifier or Final These rules should be read in conjunction with the I S A Rules

POWERS QUARRY 34th INTERNATIONAL RIDDEN REGISTERED CONNEMARA PONY CHAMPIONSHIP

Enter Class 43

Qualifying rounds will be held at designated shows.

Ponies 4 years old and over are eligible. The Championship will consist of two categories A: Ponies 4 to 6 yrs old B: Ponies 7 yrs and upwards. More than one pony in each qualifying class may be selected to compete in the final provided the judges agree that the standard is high enough.

Judge on the day must sign the qualifying entry form(s).

Pony and / or Rider once qualified are not eligible to participate in subsequent qualifiers. This rule may be waived by the Show Committee in exceptional circumstances e.g. sale of a pony or injury of rider prior to final. Permission from the Oughterard Show Committee must be granted prior to any previously qualified pony or rider competing in subsequent qualifying rounds. Failure to do so will result in the entry not being accepted.

On completion of judging at qualifiers the successful qualifier will be given all relevant entry documentation by the ring steward. This must be completed and returned, along with the

appropriate fee, to the secretary of the Oughterard show within 7 days- this rule will be strictly adhered to.

Ponies must be registered in a main Connemara Studbook. The Connemara Passport of each pony must be presented prior to judging at the qualifying show and on the day of the final.

The rider must be under 25 years on 1/01/19. Birth certificates must be produced for inspection at qualifying rounds and on the day of the final.

Registered Connemara Stallions must be ridden by rider over 14 years and under 25 years on 01/01/2019.

Jumping over plain rustic fences will be part of the qualifying rounds and final. Qualifying rounds require a minimum of 4 fences, Jumps at qualifiers should not exceed 90cms in height and 90cms in width. Entrants from shows who do not adhere to this rule will not be accepted.

The final requires a minimum of 8 fences which will include a double and a technical related distance. For category A fences must not exceed 90cms in height and 90cms in width. For category B fences must not exceed 1m in height and 1m in width.

Ponies to be ridden in a Plain Snaffle, Pelham or Double Bridle. Boots are allowed for the jumping phase only, and must be removed prior to the in-hand or Flat Sections. Martingales and Spurs are prohibited.

A performance judge must be used at qualifying shows.

Ponies will be judged on type, Confirmation, Jumping technique, way of going and action in-hand. Random Dope testing may be carried out on the day of the final. Any objection must be lodged in writing with the show secretary within half an hour following the completion of the competition, together with €50 which is refundable if the objection is upheld.

The Oughterard show committee, in consultation with the sponsor reserves the right to amend the rules as may be deemed necessary.

Phase 3 - Jumping

In the event of a tie at the conclusion of judging the combination awarded the highest points in Phase 3 will be deemed the winner. If there is a tie, the combination with the highest points in Phase 2 will be deemed the winner.

FINAL AT OUGHTERARD SHOW SUNDAY 25TH AUGUST, 2019



There are qualifiers throughout the 32 counties. The final will take place at the annual IPS Championship show at Mullingar Equestrian Centre in August 2019.

The Championship is open to 1, 2 & 3 year old Show Ponies, Show Hunter Ponies & Mountain & Moorland Ponies.

A sash will be presented to the overall yearling if the yearling is not awarded Champion or Reserve Champion at the final.

Intermediate ponies are not eligible for the championship.

The qualifier will be run as a separate class to the Young Stock Championship Ponies must be Irish Bred.

The result sheet and qualifier card with the winners details must be filled out on show day.

The runner up must also be recorded in the event of the winner being unable to attend the final. Owners must be IPS members on the day of show with a valid IPS membership card. Ponies must register with the Irish Pony Society within 7 days of qualification. Registration forms are available on the Irish Pony Society website.

No entry fee this year for qualifier class.

Results must be sent to Breda Horgan, Mileen, Kilbarry, Macroom, Co Cork (IPS Breeders Committee Secretary) within 10 days of the show date.

DUBLIN HORSE SHOW BREEDERS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER: Enter Class 117

Open to mares likely to produce performance horses, with an athletic foal at foot. Mares should be registered with an approved studbook or with Weatherby's General Studbook or Weatherby's Non

-Thoroughbred Register and have recorded breeding. Foal must be by a registered stallion.

Aim: To give recognition to breeders who breed from suitable mares to produce top quality foals with performance potential. To encourage the production of quality young stock which might, in time and with suitable nurture, achieve success in various equestrian disciplines. This class aims to serve as an important benchmark for breeders (and the industry at large) to determine the progress being made in the national herd. The Breeders' Championship is a

seminal class for the RDS and for the industry in showcasing the quality of equine talent being produced nationally for future domestic and export markets.

Rules: Passports of all competing mares must be brought to the qualifying shows for scrutiny by the judges / stewards. If valid passports are not available for inspection at the time of judging, the mare and foal will not be eligible to compete. All mare and foal combinations at both the qualifiers and Final will be shown in-hand using the triangle format (25m x 40m x 25m). Judging will be based on adjudicating the mare as a progenitor of athletic type foals with obvious performance potential.

Qualification: The top three mare and foal combinations at this qualifier will be eligible to enter and compete at the Discover Ireland Dublin Horse Show.

Animals must be Sired by a Stallion that is classified in the Irish Sport Horse Stud Book as either: Approved /Preliminary Approved/Supplementary Approved/ Recognised/Preliminary Recognised / Not Approved 1 (NA1) or a Stallion that is classified in the Irish Draught Stud Book as either CLASS 1/Class 2/ RID (GB) /RID (Can) /Grade 2 (GB)
3. The class is also open to Weatherby's registered animals, progeny of Weatherby's Thoroughbred Stallions that are not classified in the Irish Horse Register as Not Approved 2 (NA2) or ENTRY in the Irish Horse Register
4. Two Animals may be selected to qualify for the final if the judges and the I.S.A. agree the standard is high enough.
5. Exhibitors to both the qualifier and the final must have the Animals passport available for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.
6. Passports & Microchips should be read by a Vet at the Final
7. Animals Qualified for Final are not eligible to enter any other class at the show at which the final is held.
8. Those rules should be read in conjunction with the I..S.A. Rules

The aim of this Championship is to give recognition to Irish Draught mares who are producing the best purebred foals.

RULES AND CONDITIONS - Enter Class No: 116

1. Each mare and foal will be judged as a unit **with stronger emphasis** placed on the foal. **65% for the foal and 35% for the mare.**
2. Entries are confined to Irish Draught Mares with ID Foal at Foot, Mares must be registered in the Irish Horse Register with breed code ID and must be classified as Class 1 or Class 2 in the Irish Draught Horse studbook. Foals must be sired by a stallion that is classified as ID Class 1/Class 2/RID (GB) RID (Can)/Grade 2(GB).
3. Mares must have both sire and dam recorded on their passport and have an Irish Draught colt or filly foal at foot. **Foals must be led at all times.**
4. **Two mares and foals** may qualify at each show provided the judges agree the standard is high enough.
5. Exhibitors to both the qualifier and the final must have their mare's passport available for inspection prior to entry to the Judging Ring. **Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.**
6. Passports & **(Microchips if applicable)** should be read by a vet at the final.
7. One of the judges at the qualifying show must be a qualified Irish Draught Horse Judge.
8. Animals qualified for the final are not eligible to enter any other class at Bonnicolnlon show **other than qualifying classes for other ISA Finals. These rules** should be read in conjunction **with the I.S.A Rules**

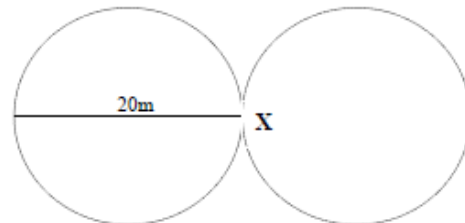

Mares and foals in the Breeders' Championship must be presented on the triangle for their conformation and movement assessment. To encourage uniformity, consistency and time efficiency, it is desirable that the presentation of animals at the triangle is properly rehearsed. Below are guidelines for competitors at the Dublin Horse Show and its qualifiers;

The horse will be presented before the judges at A where they will be assessed for conformation and movement. In the case of the Breeders' Championship, both mare and foal will be presented before the judges at A.

Animals should stand square with all four limbs bearing weight.

For mare and foal combinations, the foal should be presented behind the mare so that both animals can be clearly seen by the judges.

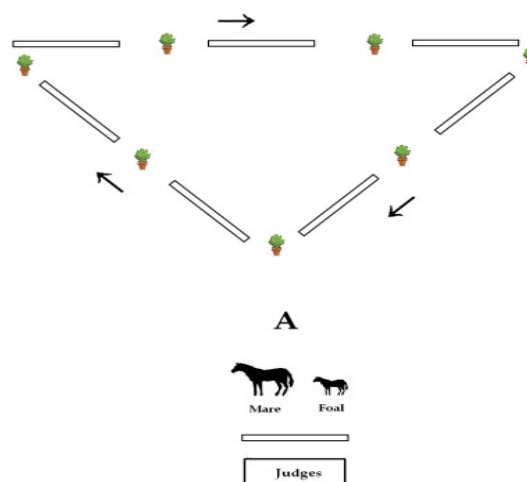
Movement will be assessed on the triangle. The exhibitor will be asked to walk and trot their animal around the triangle (**25m x 40m x 25m**) in a clockwise direction, one round in walk and one round in trot.

The triangle format allows the judges (who will be positioned at A) to assess natural paces from behind, side and in front - allowing them to easily assess freedom of shoulder, use of back, engagement of the hock, tracking up and straightness in both paces.

Care should be taken that the foal is kept along-side the mare during walk and trot phase going away from and coming back to the judges so that both mare and foal are clearly visible. When the mare and foal are being assessed for movement on the long side of the triangle, the foal should be positioned behind the mare.

Prospective owners/exhibitors are advised to familiarize both themselves and their horse/s with this layout to maximize the art of presentation. Exhibitors should ensure that the foals in particular are well handled and prepared well in advance to perform walk and trot in a balanced and calm manner around the triangle.

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING MOVEMENT OF BOVINE TO SHOWS

The Department of Agriculture implemented a number of changes on 4th February 2019 which changed the procedures and criteria applicable when applying for a Certificate of Compliance for the movement of cattle. These also impact on the certificate which is required when moving bovine to a Show.

The following sets out the criteria applicable:

- The movement of cattle to and from an Agriculture Show within the State must be recorded on the Animal Identification and Movement System (AIM).
- In line with these changes a specific certificate of Compliance for the "Movement of Bovine from a Single Holding to a Show" must now be requested prior to the movement of animals concerned.
- These certificates can be created by (i) applying online using their ag food account or (ii) where the keeper is not on line the certificate can be generated by the local Regional Veterinary Office following receipt of a NBAS31K with issue of the certificate being subject to normal criteria applicable. This form will be available on the Departments Website and will also be included with the Show Circular when issued.
- When applying for this certificate the destination herd / or Show number is not required. The certificate generated will include an "S" symbol.
- The Certificate of Compliance for a Show will continue to be valid for a period of up to 30 days. As is currently the case these can be used for the movement of animals to a number of shows during the validity period of the certificate.
- Please also note—Calves which are less than 10 days cannot be moved to a Show.

As is currently the case the Movement Notification Section of the Certificate should be Completed by the Keeper and the Show Secretary who must clearly indicate the Show Number. The Show movement should be recorded on the passport. Ultimate responsibility for fulfilling these requirements lies with the Show Secretary. If the animals move to a herd other than the source herd, the new destination herd must complete and sign the certificate also.

Completed forms should be sent by the Show Secretary to the local RVO within 7 days of the Show.

Identification

All sheep must be identified individually with appropriate ear tags issued in accordance with the requirements of the National Sheep Identification System (NSIS).

Movement Documentation

All consignments of sheep being moved must be accompanied by a completed dispatch document. Individuals details of each sheep in the consignment must be recorded on the document. Sheep from non-restricted flocks only can be moved to shows. In the case of flocks restricted following diagnosis of scrapie, sheep possessing the ARR/ARR genotype only may be exhibited. The movement of these ARR/ARR genotype sheep must be accompanied by the relevant movement permit (SCR/10), which can be obtained from the local District Veterinary Office in the county where the flock is located.

AIM Notification

The movement of sheep to and from an Agricultural Show within the State must be recorded on AIM. This is done using a copy of the owners sheep dispatch document as follows:

- 1.The owner/keeper presents the signed and completed dispatch document to the show secretary who checks it to ensure that it is completed in full.
- 2.The Show Secretary fills in the MART section of the dispatch document with (i) the show number, (ii) the date of the move back to the source holding (iii) stamps it with the Show stamp and (iv) signs the dispatch document.
- 3.The Show Secretary then forwards the completed pink section of the dispatch document to the local DVO office within 7 days of the show movement.
- 4.The Show Secretary keeps the white copy for his/her records.
- 5.The source/destination keeper keeps the yellow copy to enter it into their flock register.

Ultimate responsibility for fulfilling this requirement lies with the Show secretary.

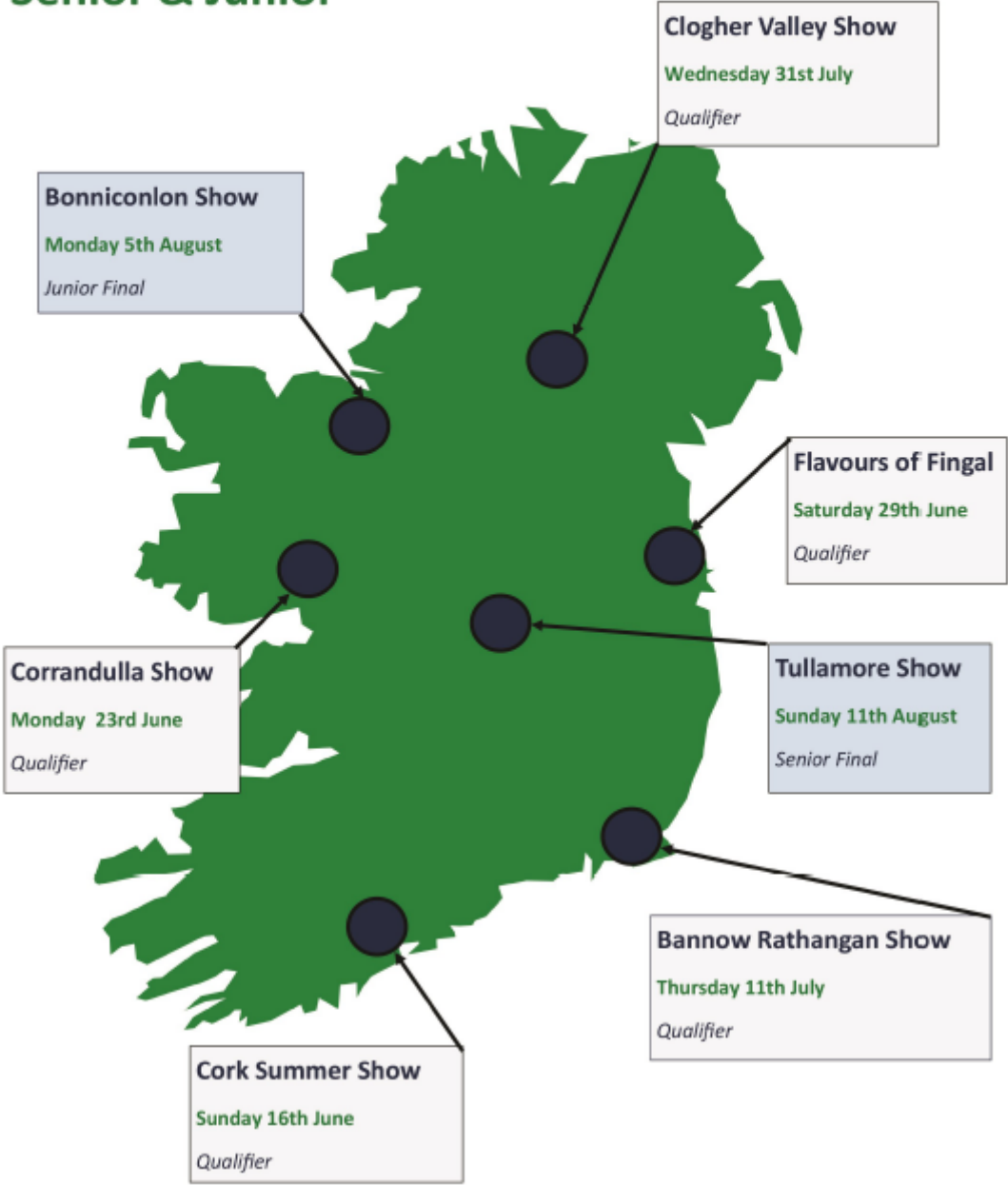
