Covid-19 Protocols All-Ireland Showing Series (Equine):

- 1. Competitions will be held behind closed doors and on timed slots. Exhibitors will be admitted to the venue one hour before their competition time and must leave within 45 minutes once they have finished competing.
- 2. Two people will be admitted per horse.
- 3. Ensure that correct details are supplied for contact tracing purposes at time for entering. One contact person per vehicle.
- 4. Details will be checked against the entry list on arrival at the venue. If you are not 2on the list, you will not be admitted.
- 5. Anyone displaying symptoms of Covid-19 should not present at the venue.
- 6. Face coverings are mandatory while competing in the ring, during presentations and in any other areas of the grounds where social distancing cannot be maintained.
- 7. There will be no hand shaking during presentations.
- 8. Exhibitors may be required to complete a health self-declaration form and temperature or other health checks on arrival (depending on prevailing regulations at the time).
- 9. All officials will be required to complete an online contact tracing and health declaration form 48 hours prior to the event.
- Every effort should be made to always maintain sufficient distance from other exhibitors.
- 11. Anybody breaching any of the safety regulations may be removed from the venue and forfeit their place in the competition.
- 12. While hand sanitiser will be provided throughout the grounds, exhibitors are advised to bring their own hand sanitiser for their use.
- 13. One-way systems will be in operation. Please follow signs, announcements and directions from officials.

Animals must be sired by a stallion that is classified in the Irish Sport Horse Stud Book as either: Approved / Preliminary Approved/Supplementary Approved/ Recognised/ Preliminary Recognised/ Not Approved 1 (NA1) or a Stallion that is



- classified in the Irish Draught Horse Stud Book as either Class 1 /Class 2/ RID (GB) /RID (Can) /Grade 2 (GB).
- b. Animals that are the progeny of Weatherby's registered stallions that are NOT classified as Not Approved 2 (NA2) or Entry in the Irish Horse Register.
- 2. Warmblood breeding is not permitted in this competition. Foals can only have the following breeds recorded in their pedigree: Irish Sport Horse, Irish Draught, Thoroughbred, Connemara Pony.
- 3. Foals must be led at all times.
- 4. Exhibitors at the final must have the mare's passport available for inspection prior to entry to the judging ring. Failure to comply with this rule will lead to immediate disqualification.
- 5. Passports & Microchips should be read by a veterinary surgeon at the final.
- 6. These rules should be read in conjunction with the I.S.A. Rules for the 2021 Showing Series.
